TBT is a ministry to university students operating on three main campuses, with an outreach on a fourth. The majority of the students on these campuses are isiZulu speakers and have travelled from far-flung rural and township areas of KZN and beyond.

Our hope is that the students we minister to will leave university not only with their degrees but with the good news of Jesus. Our prayer is that these men and women post-university will be dispersed by God into a myriad of different contexts as salt and light.

TBT MINISTRY ON CAMPUS

On campus, we prayerfully focus our ministry on three key areas: reaching widely, investing deeply, and multiplying ministry. We do this through weekly sermons, bible studies, walk-up evangelism, running conferences and events, and more!



Every year, we engage with hundreds of students through weekly walk-up evangelism, one-to-one ministry, and various events on our campuses. Students are encouraged to consider what they believe and why and are invited to wrestle with the identity and claims of Jesus Christ.

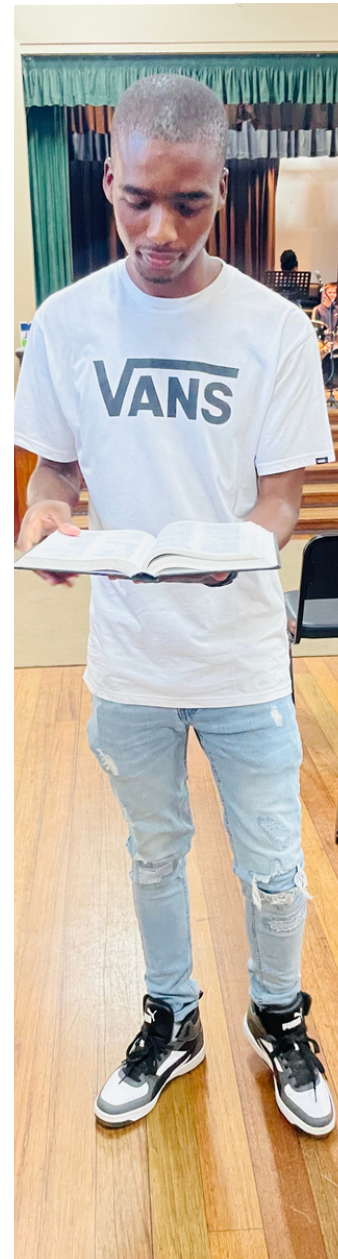
The main beliefs we encounter on campus are African Traditional Religion, nominal and cult forms of Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, and atheism.



We meet students one-on-one, host weekly sermon hours and small group bible studies on each of the campuses. TBT also runs various conferences each year. We are increasingly trying to harness social media in reaching students for Christ, including weekly posts/articles to our website in both English and isiZulu. These are also distributed via the various campus WhatsApp groups. We also run a monthly "Read Scripture with TBT" initiative where we provide guided tours through books of the Bible, aiming to help students in their own regular devotional time from the Scriptures.



Most of our equipping of students takes place in Monday night campus EQUIP sessions. Here our core focus is to teach and train our student leaders in how to read the Bible for themselves and how to teach it to others. We also run various streams of training related to evangelism and apologetics, biblical theology, as well as key doctrines. Some of this equipping also takes place in one-to-one settings, and once off seminars.





TRAINING UP THE NEXT GENERATION OF GOSPEL WORKERS!

For gospel work to continue, it is vital that more workers are trained for the harvest! Some of our TBT students finish their university degrees and desire to pursue full-time ministry. In 2023, we have 12 ministry apprentices!

TBT oversees the testing and training of these men and women through the KZN Ministry Apprenticeship programme (KZNMA) in partnership with local churches. Apprentices are usually trained for two years. Through this programme, we aim not only to extend our campus ministry but also to replenish and strengthen existing local church ministry teams and see local churches planted especially in rural and township parts of KZN. We want to see the gospel go out far and wide!



While the apprentices are with TBT, they are equipped and trained to share the life-giving news about Jesus. Apprentices are involved in practical ministry: walk-up evangelism, running small groups, meeting up one-to-one with a few students each week, and helping with administration.

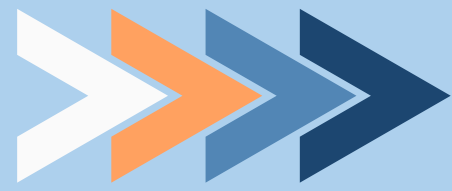

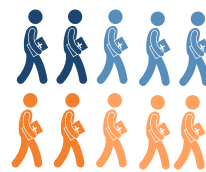
